- Verify customer age for alcohol sales.
- Preparing and serving beers, cocktails, mocktails and coffee/tea drinks.
- Operating beer and coffee equipment, including taps, kegs, espresso machines, grinders and brewers.
- Greeting customers when they enter the building
- Taking orders, including offering menu recommendations and noting dietary restrictions and customizations
- Building relationships with customers and promoting and recommending menu options to customers
- Restocking and cleaning supplies, such as cups, kegs and drink ingredients.
- Making drinks according to company recipes and standards
- Keeping the work environment and cafe seating area clean, sanitary and organized
- Cleaning countertops and behind the counter, including all work spaces
- Working the point-of-sale (POS) system to complete transactions
- Assisting with opening and closing duties, including setup, cleaning and inventory tasks
- Other duties as assigned

Responsibilities

The Bartender prepares and serves beer, cocktails and other beverages while delivering friendly, efficient customer service. They operate equipment like taps, kegerators and espresso machines, follow drink recipes, handle transactions and maintain a clean, organized workspace. The Bartender may also make espresso- and tea-based drinks. As the front-of-house team Bartenders also help create a welcoming environment and recommend products or answer customer questions about the menu.

Qualifications

- Must be 21 years old or older.
- Minimum one year of experience as a bartender in a restaurant, brewery or similar location.
- A solid understanding of food and alcohol safety practices
- Familiarity with beer and cocktail equipment and accessories
- Ability to stand, bend, kneel, twist, and lift items up to 25 pounds continuously throughout scheduled shifts.
- Ability to communicate satisfactorily with guests, ownership, management, and co-workers to their understanding, and resolve issues quickly.
- ServSafe and/or food safety training preferred, but not required. ServSafe Alcohol certification required within 30 days of hire.
- Strong familiarity with beer types, including ability to learn seasonal and rotational offerings. Knowledge of Cincinnati-based breweries and beers preferred but not required.
- Experience with or willingness to cross-train on coffee and tea operations, including understanding the coffee and tea menu.
- Flexibility to work various shifts including late nights, weekends and holidays.
- Team-oriented mindset
